JOIN US FOR AVIATION DAY THIS SATURDAY - DONATE A NON-PERISHABLE FOOD ITEM -

FORT MYERS, Fla. (March 19, 2018) – Aviation Day 2018 will be held Saturday, April 7 at Page Field from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. with free admission and parking. Aviation Day is an annual community event hosted by the Lee County Port Authority with the purpose of increasing community awareness of our airports. The event is held on the ramp on the north side of Page Field off North Airport Road, east of U.S. 41 and south of Colonial Blvd. Parking is available off North Airport Road and U.S. 41 with complimentary shuttle bus transportation to the event.

There will be two featured aircraft at this year's event - a Douglas C-54E, sponsored by Owen-Ames-Kimball Company, and a rare Douglas SBD-5, sponsored by Kimley-Horn. The C-54E "Spirit of Freedom" is a flying museum and memorial housed in the original aircraft used in the historical Berlin Airlift that took place in 1948-49 and is commemorating its 70th anniversary this year. The SBD-5 "Dauntless" was a World War II carrier-based scout, dive and torpedo bomber.

In addition, there will be free children's activities, including inflatable slides and bounce houses, sponsored by Suncoast Credit Union, and clowns and face painting, sponsored by HMSHost. Other attractions will include antique, experimental and general aviation aircraft, airplane and helicopter rides (for a fee), airport police and fire department demonstrations, aviation-themed shopping, food and more.
