WINGS OF FREEDOM TOUR TO ARRIVE AT PAGE FIELD JAN. 28 - TOURS AND FLIGHTS OFFERED -

Aviation enthusiasts and history buffs will have the opportunity to tour or take flight in rare World War II aircraft when the Collings Foundation brings its B-17 Flying Fortress heavy bomber, B-24 Liberator heavy bomber and P-51D Mustang fighter to Page Field from Jan. 28 to Jan. 31, 2019. The stop in Fort Myers is part of the Collings Foundation's Wings of Freedom Tour, an annual 110-city nationwide tour in its 30th year of showcasing rare treasures of aviation history.

The planes will be displayed on the ramp at Base Operations at Page Field (5200 Captain Channing Page Drive), off Fowler Street. Walkthrough tours are available for a donation of \$15 for adults and \$5 for children under 12. World War II veterans can tour the aircraft at no cost. Discounted rates for school groups will also be available.

Ground tours and display hours are 12 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. on Monday, Jan. 28; 9 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. on Tuesday, Jan. 29 and Wednesday, Jan. 30; and 9 am to 12 p.m. on Thursday, Jan. 31.
