ALASKA AIRLINES TO START SERVICE TO FORT MYERS IN NOVEMBER 2020 - NONSTOP WEEKLY FLIGHTS TO LOS ANGELES AND SEATTLE -

The Lee County Port Authority is pleased to announce that Alaska Airlines will begin service to Fort Myers in November 2020. Alaska Airlines will bring the first nonstop service from Los Angeles International Airport (LAX) and Seattle-Tacoma International Airport (SEA) to Southwest Florida International Airport (RSW) on Nov. 20, 2020. Both flights to LAX and SEA will operate four times weekly on a 737 aircraft.
